

Agreement on Collaboration between RECLA and eucen

The "Red de Educación Continua de América Latina y Europa" (RECLA) and the "European university continuing education network" (EUCEN) are both committed to expanding high quality continuing and professional tertiary education opportunities. In the interest of advancing this common goal, RECLA and EUCEN have agreed to collaborate in the following areas:

- I. **MEMBERSHIP:** RECLA and EUCEN are both institutionally-based membership associations. The focus of EUCEN is higher education institutions in Europe. RECLA's institutional members are accredited higher education institutions in America and Europe, from Spanish and Portuguese speaking countries specifically.


Terms of Collaboration: It is agreed that RECLA will provide EUCEN with an affiliate membership in RECLA and that EUCEN, for its part, will provide RECLA with an affiliate membership in EUCEN. As affiliate members in each other's organizations, the respective Secretariats of RECLA and EUCEN will be entitled to member website access and to the publications (such as newsletters and results from projects). This affiliate membership will be free of charge to both organisations.

- II. **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:** RECLA and EUCEN regard the development of continuing educators' capacities to be a central organizational function. Both RECLA and EUCEN organise conferences, seminars and workshops where professionals can learn about the latest trends, research and best practices in the field, discuss ideas, and exchange experiences.

Terms of Collaboration: RECLA and EUCEN are committed to the support of activities which strengthen formal and informal networking activities among continuing education professionals. It is agreed that both associations will make the other visible to its members by disseminating the other association's activities and announcements. It is also agreed that RECLA offers any current member of EUCEN the opportunity to register for the RECLA Annual Conference at RECLA-members rate. EUCEN, for its part, will offer any current RECLA member the opportunity to register for its Annual Conference at the EUCEN-members rate. Members of RECLA and EUCEN will need to identify themselves as such when registering. Both RECLA and EUCEN will collaborate in the other's events proposing speakers and experts in specific topics if this is requested and as far as it is possible.

- III. **This Agreement will remain in effect for a period of three years from the date of its signing and will automatically renew for one-year periods thereafter. Either party may dissolve the Agreement after the initial three-year period by giving one year's written notice to the other party.**
